

## **Admission Appeals Timetable for Year R (*starting school in reception*) and Year 3 (*Infant to Junior school transfer*) in September 2022**

For **community** and **voluntary controlled** schools (i.e. schools for which Hampshire County Council is the admission authority) appeals will follow the timetable below. This is in line with the DfE's School Admissions (England) (Coronavirus) (Appeals Arrangements) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2021.

*For infant, junior and all-through primary schools which are their own admission authority (i.e. Academy, Foundation, Trust and Voluntary Aided schools), please refer to the individual school for their appeal dates.*

National notification date for on-time applicants	Tuesday 19 April 2022
Notification date for late applicants ( <i>whose applications received after 15 January and before 19 April 2022</i> )	Wednesday 27 April 2022
Deadline date for parents wishing to lodge an appeal ( <i>returning completed appeal papers to the County Council</i> )	Thursday 19 May 2022
Appeal hearings to be held	From 06 June to 21 July, inclusive
Decision letters to be sent	Within seven calendar days of hearing

### **Please note**

- (i) Appeals lodged after 19 May 2022 will be heard during the above dates if possible. Where it is not achievable to hold an appeal between the above dates, the hearing will be scheduled within 30 school days (excluding any school holidays) of the appeal being lodged. Appeals lodged on or after 10 June 2022 may not be heard until the autumn term.
- (ii) Appellants will receive at least 14 calendar days' notice of the exact date and location of their appeal hearing.
- (iii) Following the lodging of an appeal, additional papers may be submitted to the Appeals Service until 14 calendar days before the hearing. Evidence submitted after this date will be considered by the panel but this may lead to an adjournment and significant delays.
