Queen Mary's College on Wednesday to take part in a variety of activities linked to the key scientific ideas behind their school topic (right). Strike Action by the National Union of Teachers (NEU) - The NEU has called it's members to strike over it's ongoing dispute with the government over teachers' pay. Strikes will take place

on the following dates:

Wednesday 1 February 2023: all eligible members in England and Wales.

Tuesday 14 February 2023: all eligible members in Wales.

Tuesday 28 February 2023: all eligible members in the following English regions: Northern, North West, Yorkshire & The Humber.

Wednesday 1 March 2023: all eligible members in the following English regions: East Midlands, West Midlands, Eastern.

<u>Thursday 2 March 2023:</u> all eligible members in the following English regions: London, South East, South West.

<u>Wednesday 15 March 2023:</u> all eligible members in England and Wales.

Thursday 16 March 2023: all eligible members in England and Wales.

The dates underlined above may impact provision as St Bede's depending on whether NEU members decide to strike or not. It is possible that on these days, certain classes may have to close, if we are unable to provide adequate cover in the event of teacher absence. We will inform parents further about this situation, when we are in a better position to determine the level of impacthopefully next week.
